

Captain's Update #8 – September 25, 2017

Start Times

As you know, there were some pacing estimate issues that had to be cleared up, and I asked each of you to compare the “system generated” estimate with your own, and to notify me if they differed by more than an hour. For those that did that, thank you! Because there were a number of revisions to be made, new start times have been assigned. These times are FINAL - Please do not ask for a change unless you see some glaring error (like you are going finish before 1:00 pm or after 9:00 pm or something like that). Runner Registration

Double check to make sure everyone is on your roster, and that the info is complete and correct, including shirt sizes.

Shirts

Shirts are gender neutral this year...which I suppose is men's sizing. Shirts will be distributed at the Starting Line for all runners who have a size entered. If your runners don't have a shirt size in by **Sunday, October 8**, they have to wait till the Finish Line to get their shirt.

Adding/Removing Runners

After that date, edits must be made at the STARTING LINE ONLY at Jim Beam, and will carry a stiff \$30 administrative fee – ouch!

Any runner that is NOT on your roster as of end of day October 8 must be at Van 1 Check In - in order to check in and sign a waiver.

Team Bib # is your ‘Team Number’ - please drill this # into your runners' heads (makes everyone's life easier for relay weekend)

Team Division

Race Division – If you need to change your race division, please e-mail me directly. **DO NOT** change this on the registration system, as the change will not be effective. I need to be notified directly for a change to be made.

Driver Registration

ALL DRIVERS ARE REQUIRED TO REGISTER. Unfortunately, the current team registration system we use is not designed to accommodate drivers – so we are using a different system. Keep in mind – this is for those who are ONLY Drivers. Runners who are driving do not need to register. Please ask your drivers to register using the link below. They will need to know the following: 1. Team Number; 2. Captain Name; and 3. Team Name.
