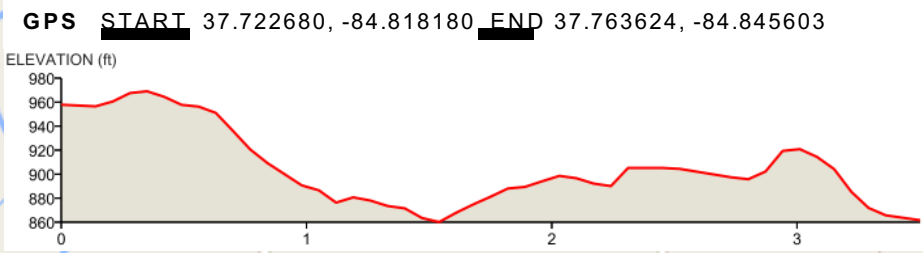
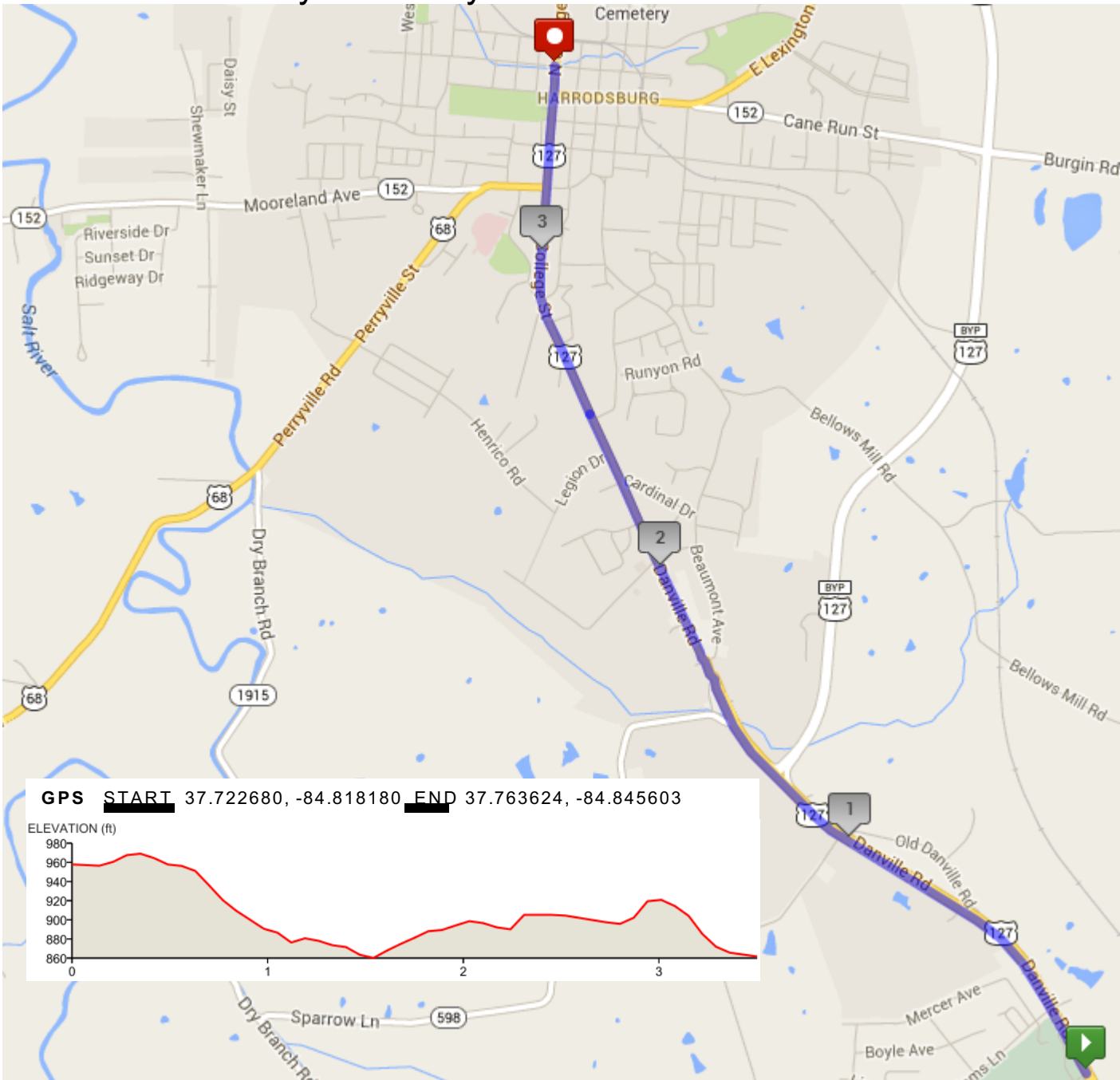


# Leg 19 (E)

An extremely short run down into Kentucky's oldest city and right by historic Fort Harrod. No turns – just full stream ahead!

- 0.0 mi.** - Continue north on US-127
- 1.2 mi.** - Continue straight past the traffic light for US-127 Bypass
- 3.5 mi.** - Exchange is at the intersection with Broadway – just short of the RR tracks

## 3.5 Miles - Kentucky's First City



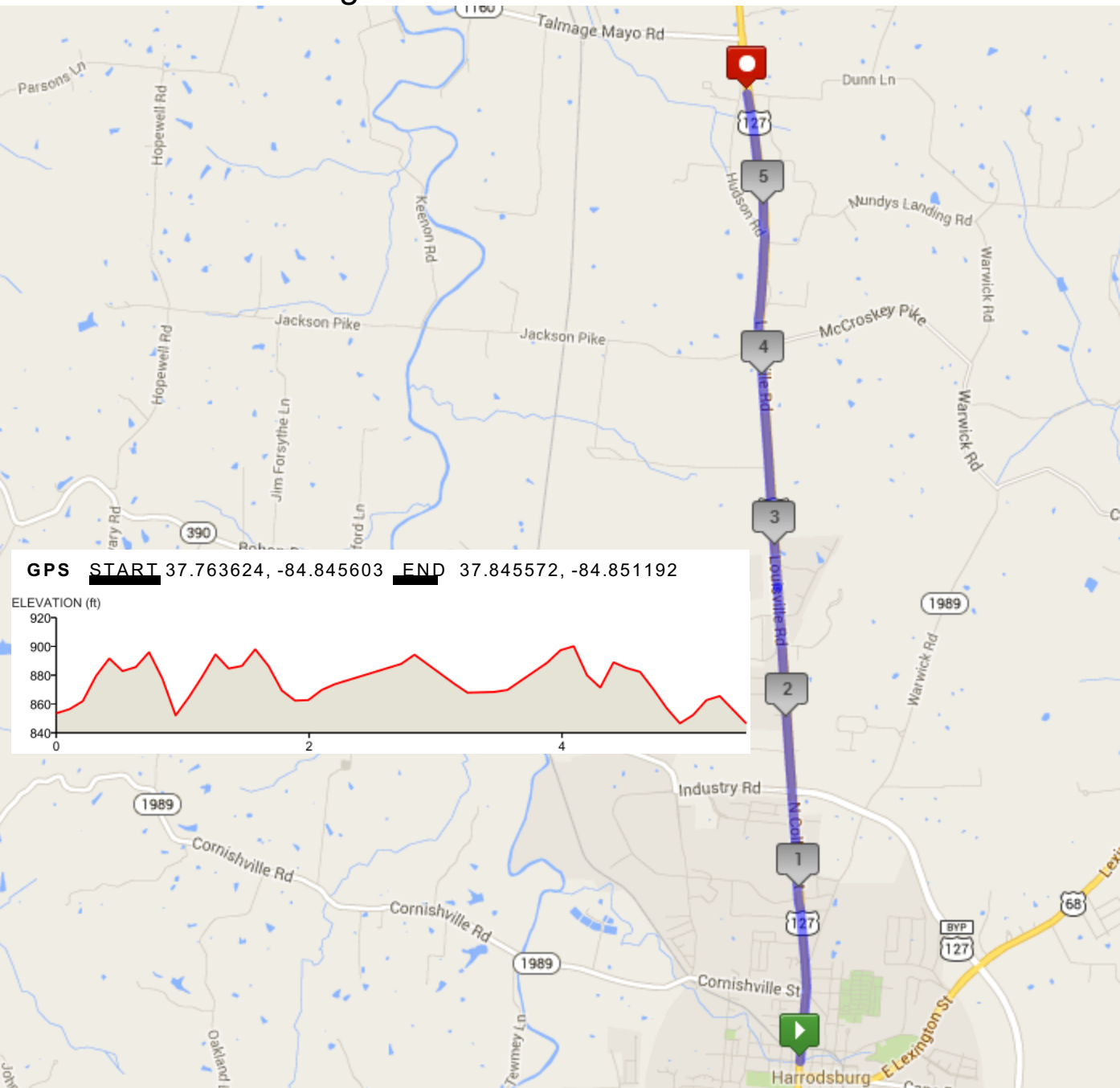
# Leg 20 (M)

Keeping it simple for you in the wee hours of the night/morning. Straight up US-127.

- 0.0 mi.** - Cross the RR tracks to continue your team's journey north
- 1.6 mi.** - Continue north on US-127 through US-127 Bypass / KY-390 intersection
- 5.7 mi.** - Exchange point is at the Kountry Kupboard Market

**VANS** - You will be instructed to enter the parking area near the runners' exchange and park on one side **ONLY** of the street. The road is one-way traffic only. For the safety of the runners, you will exit this parking area by following this road in the same one-way fashion until you meet US-127 again. Turn left to rejoin the race course.

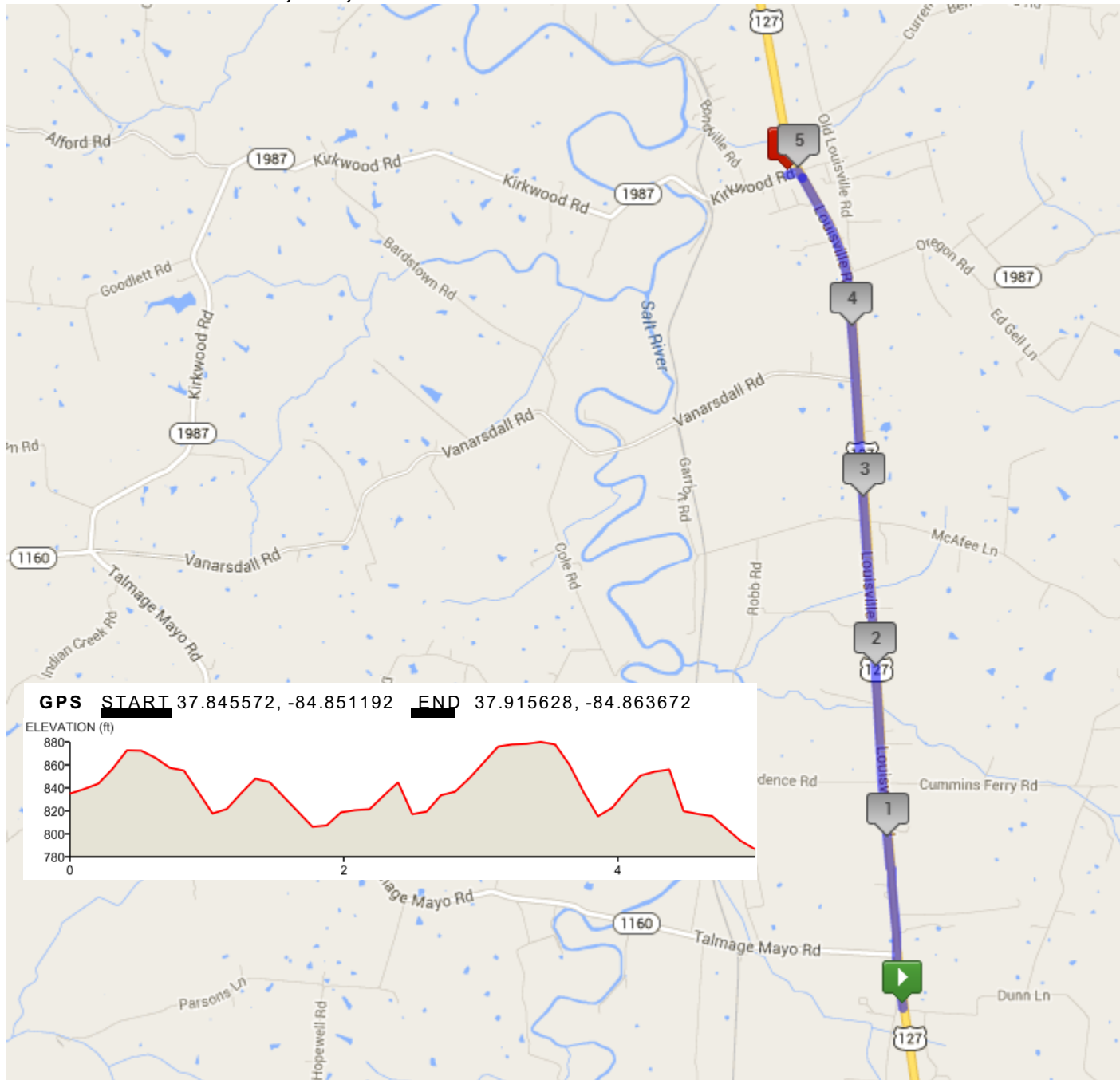


# 5.1 Miles - Salvisa, KY, USA

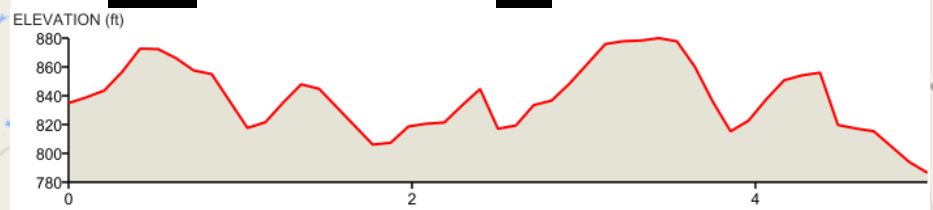
# Leg 21 (M)

Again, it's hard to get lost. Course continues to roll along US-127 North.

- 0.0 mi.** - Continue north on US-127
- 2.0 mi.** - Pass fancy stone wall and gated mansion on left
- 3.3 mi.** - Big silo on the right
- 4.3 mi.** - Continue north on US-127 at KY-1987 intersection
- 5.0 mi.** - Left on KY-1987 (Kirkwood Rd). Exchange is just ahead at Salvisa Baptist Church

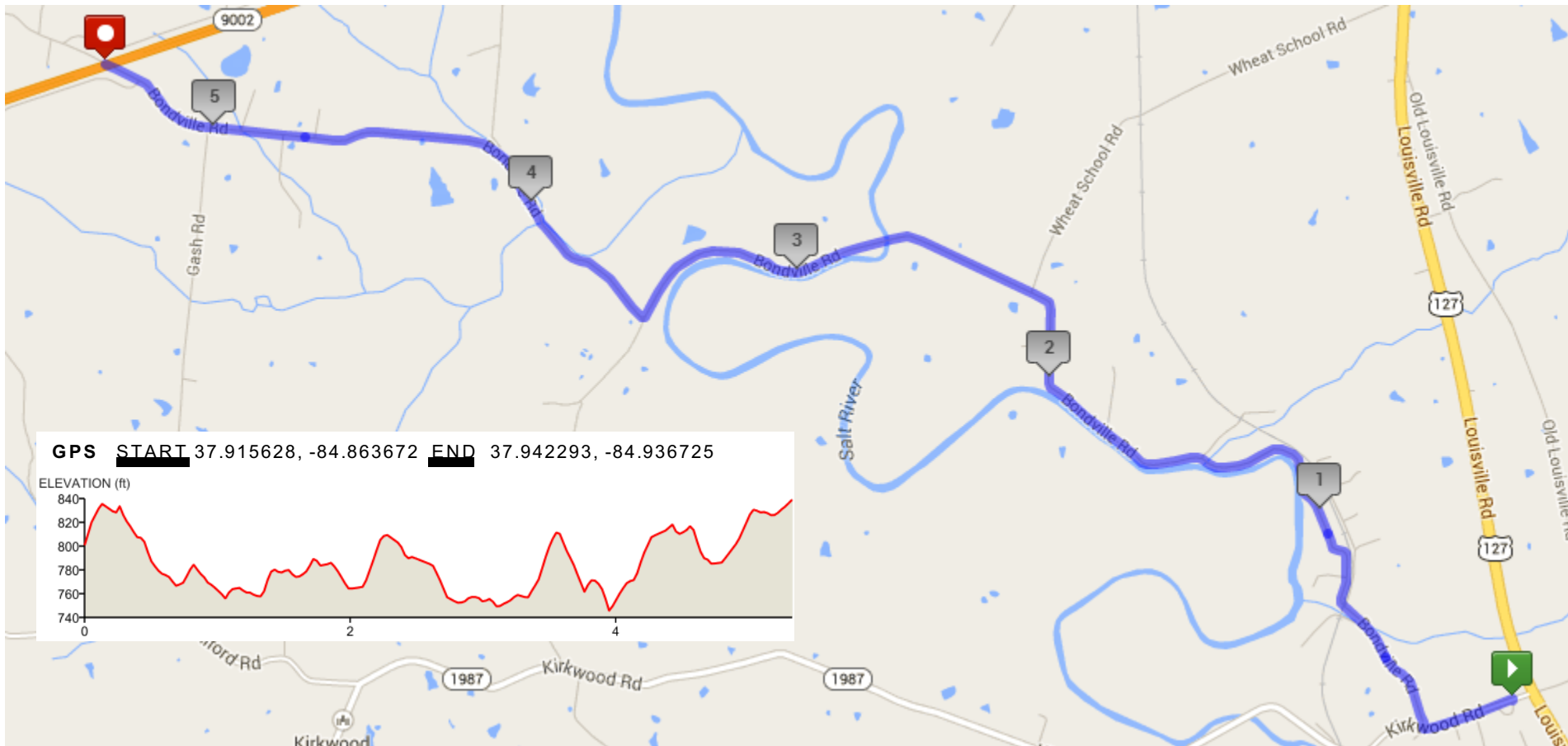

# Leg 22 (M)



As the sun rises, you turn off the main roads and hit some remote country roads. There are a lot of twists, but no turns except the one at the start

**0.0 mi.** - Begin with a slow gradual climb before turning right on Bondsville Rd.

**1.4 mi.** - Cross bridge with guardrails

**2.7 mi.** - Cross wide concrete bridge

**3.5 mi.** - 90 degree curve to the right

**5.4 mi.** - Exchange is at the Bluegrass Parkway overpass

**VANS** - Must park only on Paxton Rd – past exchange and overpass – and then only on RIGHT side of road. NO parking on left side of road.

## 4.3 Miles - Four Roses – Smitten at First Smell

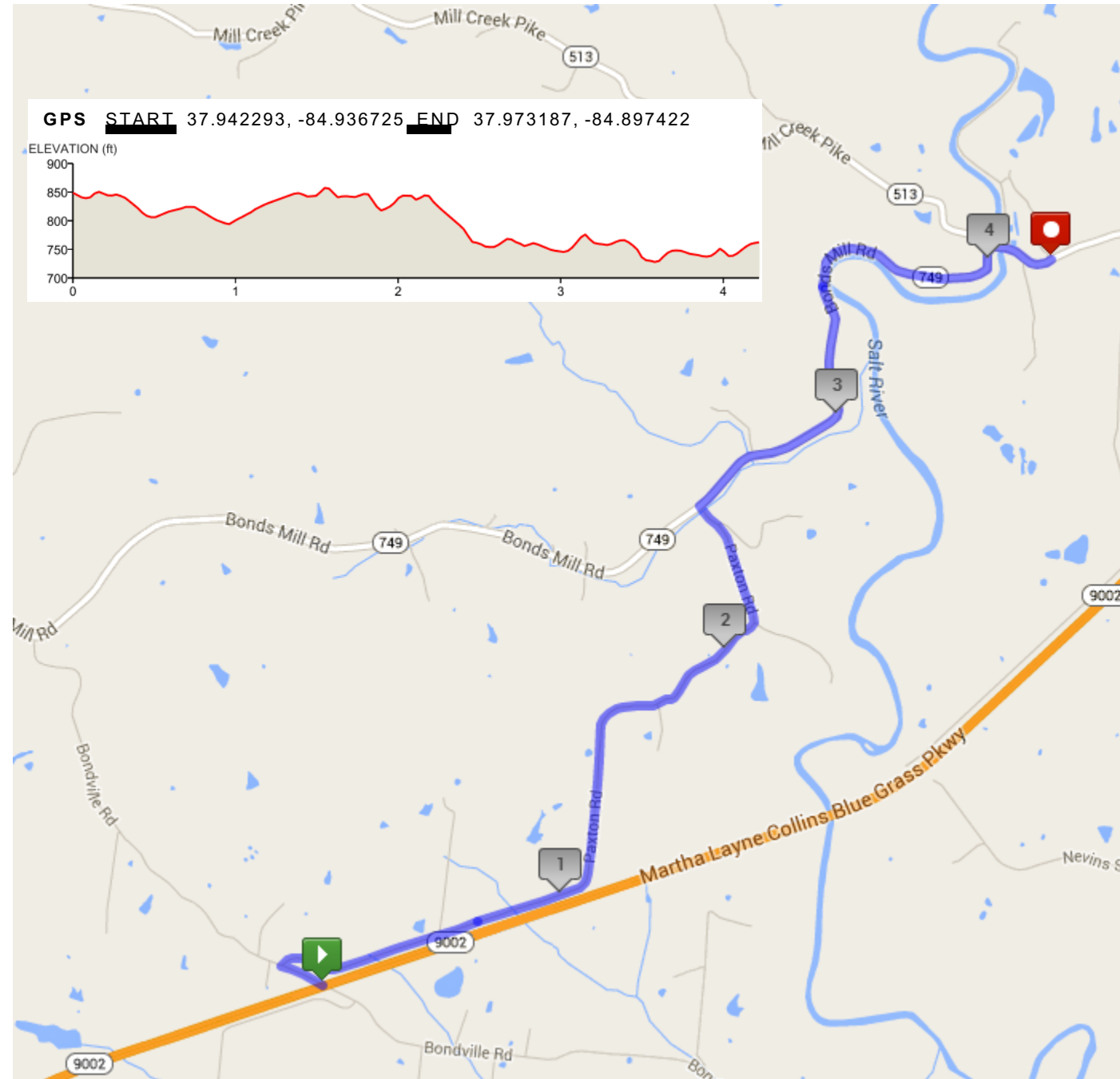
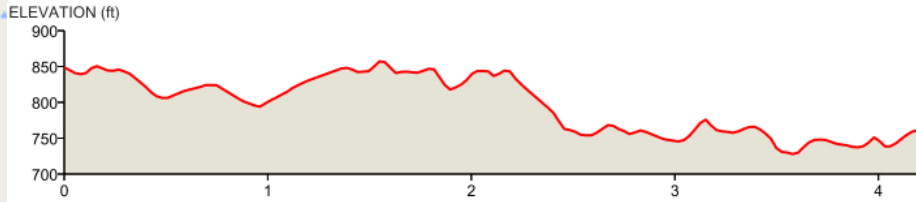
# Leg 23 (E)

With the coming of light, you are back to the “Land of Bourbon.” This short and mostly downhill leg runs along lightly traffic country roads, ending at Four Roses Distillery.

**0.0 mi.** - Make an immediate right on Paxton Rd to begin a long and straight stretch  
**1.0 mi.** - Sharp left curve  
**2.4 mi.** - Turn right on KY-749 (Bonds Mill Rd)  
**4.0 mi.** - Turn right across a concrete bridge to continue on Bonds Mill Rd.  
**4.3 mi.** - The unique and beautiful Four Roses Visitor Center welcomes you!

**VANS** - You must park according to onsite staff and special parking instructions. Violators will be disqualified – zero tolerance!

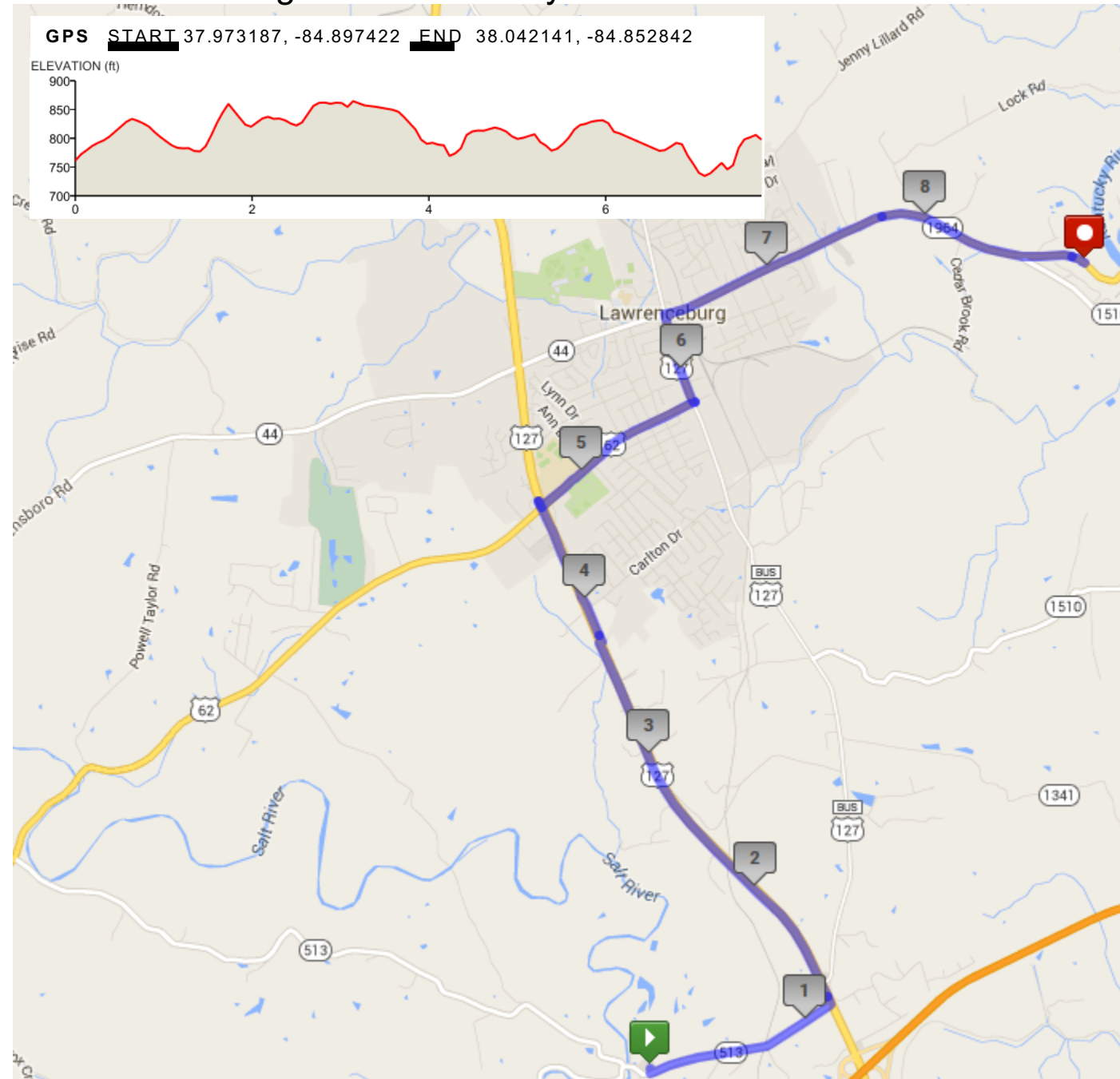
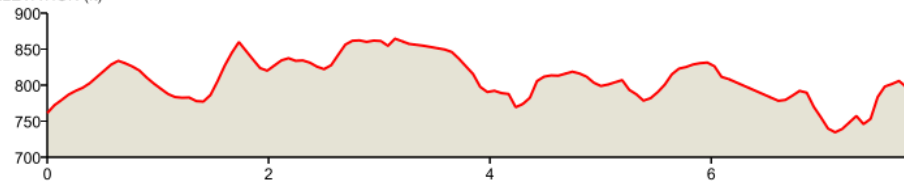

## Leg 24 (D)

This is a long one for so early in the morning, but reaching Wild Turkey's new visitor center is certainly worth the labor of love.

- 0.0 mi.** - Exit exchange area by bearing left onto Bonds Mill Rd
- 1.1 mi.** - Turn left on US-127 and follow for 3.4 miles
- 4.5 mi.** - Turn right and cross this busy highway - with the assistance of race officials - onto US-62 (W. Broadway)
- 5.6 mi.** - Turn left onto Bus. 127/S. Main Street
- 6.2 mi.** - Turn right to follow US-62 (Woodford Street)
- 8.7 mi.** - Arrive at Wild Turkey!

**VANS** - Return to northbound US-127 Bypass and at 4.5 mile mark DO NOT follow runners (watch close as they will be crossing the road), but keep going straight and then turn right on KY-44 / US-62 (past the Taco Bell and Rite Aid on the left). Follow this road through town and to the distillery parking.

Parking is tight at these historic distilleries. As with Four Roses, you must park according to onsite staff and special parking instructions. Violators will be disqualified - sadly, we mean it!
